The *South African Journal of Science* is offering mentoring opportunities for early career researchers to gain valuable editorial experience working closely with an Associate Editor and the editorial office. The opportunity is open to **emerging researchers in South Africa** who have a PhD and a publication record, but little or no editorial experience.

The mentorships for 2023/24 are in the fields of:

- **Agriculture and Forestry**
- **Archaeology, Anthropology and Palaeontology**
- **Cell, Molecular and Health Sciences** and
- **Engineering and Technology**

Applications should be submitted to sajs@assaf.org.za and must include:

- The mentorship for which you are applying.
- A CV including a list of published papers and three references.
- A motivation detailing (1) your suitability as a candidate, (2) your aspirations for the *South African Journal of Science*, and (3) your expectations of the mentorship.

The mentorship is for a period of one year. It is an unpaid, part-time position and can be accomplished as part of current academic responsibilities. Candidates can be based anywhere in South Africa.
