## Call for PhD External Examiners

A call is made for a database of External Examiners for PhD theses from the University of Zululand's Department of Anthropology and Development Studies under the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences. The titles of the studies are as follows:

4. ***Exploring the Impact of Environmental, Social and Corporate Governance (ESG) on Community Development (The Case of eThekwini Municipality and Warri, Delta State).***
5. ***The contribution of small-scale agriculture to the sustainability of livelihoods among the rural poor in South Africa: The case of King-Cetshwayo District Municipality in KwaZulu Natal***
6. ***Leadership Development among Women in King Cetshwayo District Municipality, KwaZulu-Natal, South Africa***
7. ***Exploring Gentrification in Durban CBD, Point Precinct and Its Impact On The Access To Low-Cost Housing In Durban Central***



The students should submit these final theses in the first week of December 2024. The supervisors should be holders of PhD Degrees in Anthropology and Development Studies, or other areas related or relevant to the studies. A good supervision record indicating the number of theses and dissertations that one has examined are extremely critical indicators for consideration for this assignment. The Department is looking for three external examiners per theses. One should be from South Africa, one from the rest of the continent (Africa) and one based globally (outside Africa).
